Prizes for home workers up for grabs

FALKIRK workers who ply their trade at home are being encouraged to enter a new series of awards.

To mark National Work from Home Day, tomorrow (Friday), Remote Employment, a website that advertises home-based, flexible and remote working, has launched The Home Worker Awards.

It will aim to highlight how home working benefits individuals and the wider public.

The Home Worker of the Year will receive a trophy and an array of prizes to improve their 'homework'.
